

APPENDIX B – COMMITTEES/GOVERNANCE STRUCTURE

Board of Directors

The CACUBO Board of Directors shall consist of the President, First Vice President, Second Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, First and Second Past Presidents, four Constituency Council members (one from each – Comprehensive/Doctoral Institution, Community College, Research University, and Small Institution) and up to four other members at-large. The terms for the Constituency Council board members will align with their appointment to the NACUBO Constituency Council whenever possible. Each Constituency Council Representative and at-large member shall be elected for a two-year term and shall be eligible to succeed himself/herself as an at-large member for one additional two-year term. A board member who has served the maximum number of terms for their position shall not be eligible to be elected back to any board position for the duration of one two-year term, unless they are elected into the presidential track. Individuals who have previously held board positions will be eligible to be elected back on the board one time, with one reappointment, per the term limits as described above. In no case should an individual serve on the Board in any capacity for more than ten (10) years in total.
